Cycling is one of the easiest, cheapest and most enjoyable ways of keeping fit, travelling to and from school.

Bikeability is cycling proficiency for the 21st century, giving riders the skills and confidence to cycle in today's traffic conditions. Riders will complete cycle training at the school using roads nearby. Riders are given high visibility vests to wear during the sessions. All instructors are fully qualified Bikeability instructors, cycling coaches and ride leaders. We are all DBS checked and first aid qualified.

In order to participate, the rider needs access to a bicycle (in good working order, including 2 working brakes), a helmet (we can provide these) and suitable clothing. Please allow for bad weather and bring a change of clothing and waterproofs if you have them. If the rider would like to take part but does not have a bike and/or helmet Go Velo can supply one for a small fee - see the online link to request whilst providing consent.
